ACID GHOST RINSE

Acid Ghost Rinse is a remover for any remaining pigment graffiti ghosting. This acidic after rinse will fizz out remaining ghosting while at the same time stabilising and neutralising the pH.

Acid Ghost Rinse is also an effective general purpose concrete and brick cleaner. It can help remove rust, oil, mud, atmospheric dirt, light mortar smears and many other light stains.

Not suitable for use on limestone – use a Limestone and Masonry Afterwash.

Protect surrounding surfaces and beware of wind drift.

Always test each type of surface to ensure suitability and desired results. Apply test area according to the following application procedures.

1. Apply to the surface whilst still damp.
2. Apply by brush Acid Ghost Rinse onto the surface
3. Allow to dwell for 2 to 5 minutes.
4. Rinse off using a pressure washer. Do not use water hotter than 60°C.
5. Repeat if ghosting remains.

Cleaning and Neutralisation

1. Dilute the product to appropriate strength. Normally 3 parts water to 1 part Graffiti Ghost Rinse.
2. Prewet the surface and follow above procedure from 1 to 4.

Coverage Rates

Coverage rates will vary according to the character of the surface.

5 litre plastic containers
