DESCRIPTION:

Car parks, paving, block paving, shopping malls, areas that are subject to heavy wear and staining. Prevents frost damage, prevents organic growth.

COLOUR RANGE:

Clear, invisible.

Does not affect original colour.

Moisture vapour permeable

COVERAGE RATE:

This is dependant upon the porosity of the substrate. The figures quoted below are given only as guidance. One application required

Granite.....15m²/litre

Marble.....13m²/litre

Block paving.....8m²/litre

Pre-cast slabs.....8m²/litre

Facing brickwork.....5m²/litre

Concrete.....5m²/litre

Concrete blockwork...3m²/litre

Self-coloured render...3m²/litre

DRYING TIME:

Touch dry:.....2-3 hours

Waterproof:.....24 hours

PREPARATION: Ensure surfaces to be treated are clean, free from contamination and dry.

APPLICATION: Impregnation to be applied by flood-coating method using a low-pressure spray equipment of the knapsack type, or by brush/roller. Application should be to full saturation commencing at the top and working downwards. Two applications are required on wood with only one application required on masonry, brickwork etc. Do not apply at temperatures below 5°C.

EQUIPMENT CARE: All equipment should be cleaned with water immediately after use.

STORAGE: Store away from direct sunlight and sources of heat. Protect from frost.

SHELF LIFE: 12 months (in original sealed container).
