Malcleanse - Graffiti Shadow Remover

Malcleanse - Graffiti Shadow Remover an alkaline cleaner for the removal of stubborn graffiti shadows from brickwork, stone and concrete, also for removing general soiling and staining from brickwork.

Contains: POTASSIUM HYDROXIDE

Can be used after using Malcleanse - Graffiti Remover Gel to remove ghosting effect left.

ADVANTAGES:

Will effectively remove unsightly shadows remaining after graffiti removal. Will also remove general soiling and staining from brickwork.

COLOUR :

Amber coloured liquid.

PACK SIZE:

Supplied in 5 Litre can

COVERAGE RATE:

Apply a liberal coating with a brush, the time required for penetration varies according to the thickness and age of the material to be removed.

Should be applied at 5 m²/Litre.

PREPARATION:

Areas to be cleaned should be wetted prior to application to prevent streaking.

APPLICATION:

Apply undiluted Malcleanse Graffiti Shadow Remover with a bristle brush to the affected area, starting at the bottom edge and working upwards. More than one application may be required.

Rinse off after with lots of water best if rinsing is done with high pressure washer.

For graffiti shadow removing do not dilute.

For use as an **Alkaline Cleaning Agent** dilute 1:3 (1 part Malcleans GSR to 3 parts water for light cleaning. For heavy duty cleaning dilute 1:2. Rinse very thoroughly after.

STORAGE:

Store away from direct sunlight and sources of heat.

Protect from frost.

SHELF LIFE:

12 months (in original sealed container).

Contains: POTASSIUM HYDROXIDE (ph14) MORE THAN 5% SIN1814
